



What Makes a Good Presentation?

DESIGN

- Should match your purpose.
- Should be interesting...
 - ...but should not distract.
- Transitions should be subtle and appropriate.
- Pictures should contribute meaningfully.

DESIGN

- Things to avoid:
 - Loud, difficult to read fonts.
 - Text too small to read.
 - Text that blends in with the background.
 - Too many pictures!



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- Things to avoid:
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 - Text too small to read.
 - Text that blends in with the background.
 - Too many pictures!
 - Long or unnecessary animations.
 - Long or unnecessary transitions.



INFORMATION

- Should be a summary of what you have to say – do not paste your entire speech on the slide.
 - Never simply read your slides!
- Should be short and to-the-point.
 - (easy to take notes from)

IMAGES

- Should support your message.
- Should not distract.
